I/We understand that:

MCH is a not-for-profit organization and depends upon prompt payment of tuition to remain viable. Failure to pay tuition on time may result in termination of enrollment. Those who are having difficulty with tuition payments are responsible to communicate this to the Head of School. Withdrawal from school requires 60 days notice. Enrollment Agreements will be updated/renewed prior to January 2021.

Emergency Child Care has been available throughout the current pandemic. Even if there is another shelter-in-place mandate, our expectation is that we should be able to remain open. If a child needs to be excluded from school due to illness, it will be treated like any other sickness. If the school is forced to close in its entirety, the Board would assess the situation and whether it would be possible to offer partial refunds, but no

assurances can be given in advance. By default, all tuition obligations are 100% non-refundable.

For the safety of the entire MCH community, it is required that everyone be familiar with the policies in the MCH COVID-19 Health & Safety Handbook and agree to follow those procedures. Because the situation is changing rapidly, further adjustments may be required by MCH. While MCH has developed practices and procedures consistent with guidance from federal and state regulators, you also acknowledge that there is a risk of exposure to coronavirus by enrolling at MCH, and that MCH is not responsible for that exposure or risk.

For the safety of all those at school, any behaviors that put the health of other children or staff at risk during this time will result in a call to caregivers for immediate pick-up. This may include: spitting, biting, removing masks from staff members' faces, or any other behaviors that increase the risks to our staff or impact the school's ability to maintain a safe environment for the children and our and our community. An assessment meeting will be scheduled with the Head of School and guardians before a child may come back to school.
